Access:

Starting from May 30th and throughout the games period, we recommend taking Line 6 to Bir-Hakeim station or the RER C to Champ de Mars station to reach Vedettes de Paris, avoiding bus lines.

During the games period (from July 26th to September 9th), you will not need any special documents to access Vedettes de Paris on foot, by non-motorized two-wheelers (bicycles and scooters), or by public transport.

Note: We advise against coming by car.
